# COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

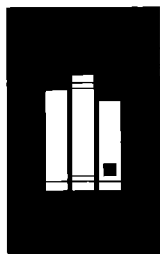
The Ohio State Academy allows outstanding high school students to enroll in Ohio State classes while still in high school.

The Academy program is the Ohio State implementation of College Credit Plus created by the State of Ohio and follows all state requirements and regulations for participation. Students gain an understanding of the expectations from college faculty, exposure to classes that aren't available in high school, and preparation for their college major.



### Where do students take classes?

Classes are offered on campus and online. Students can enroll at the Columbus campus or any regional campus: Lima, Mansfield, Marion, Newark or The Agricultural Technical Institute (ATI) in Wooster.



### What classes can students take?

Academy students may enroll in courses where they meet the course prerequisites. There may be limits based on the number of seats available or the time that the class meets. Most Academy students enroll in courses that meet general education requirements. These may be English, math, social sciences, arts and humanities, history, and foreign language courses.

Students wishing to earn credit that may transfer to another college or university should contact their desired college for information on the transfer process at that institution.



### What are the admission criteria?

Admission criteria will depend on the campus a student wishes to attend. By Ohio legislation, the admissions policies mirror admission for incoming first-year students.

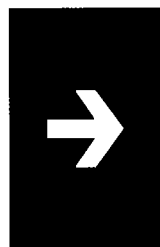
#### Columbus campus and online students:

- High school curriculum and performance (class rank, GPA)
- College admissions standardized tests: ACT, SAT
- Accelerated curriculum (Honors, AP, IB)
- Ability and desire to contribute to a diverse campus community
- Leadership, co-curricular and work experiences
- Competitiveness of high school
- Status as a first-generation college student
- Outstanding talent in a particular area
- High school performance was adversely affected by physical, mental or learning environment factors
- Eligible for and will benefit from organized support services at Ohio State

#### Regional campuses:

Students must meet the "Remediation-Free Guidelines of the State of Ohio" to be admitted.

1. File the "Letter of Intent" with your high school no later than **April 1**. This does not commit you to participating in College Credit Plus, but will keep your options open through the next academic year.
