

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

Students should write an **essay of 500 words maximum** discussing their most common distractions while driving and how they plan to put an end to those deadly habits.

Eligibility

In order to qualify for the Looking Forward Scholarship, applicants must:

- Either be enrolled in a college, university, or trade school for the Fall 2023 semester OR graduating from high school no later than Summer 2023.
- Submit all application materials by Monday, July 31, 2023.

What should I write about?

We want students to examine the ways they become distracted while driving, including digital and real-world interruptions. Examples of these types of distractions include texting, scrolling through social media, playing video games, changing music, wearing headphones, applying makeup, reading, or turning around to talk to passengers. We then want you to reflect on why those distractions are dangerous and how you intend to put an end to them.
