Scholarships are awarded in amounts of \$1,000. To qualify for the scholarship, a student:

- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Must have a career goal in the natural gas and oil industry.
- Must be an OHIO resident OR a student attending, or planning to attend, an accredited OHIO college, university, technical or trade school.
- Must have and maintain a grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 or higher.

	Provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, employer or other mentor figure. • Note: Recommendations from family members are not acceptable.
	Provide an essay consisting of no less than 250 words, and no more than 1 page in length (12 pt. font, single-spaced), detailing your career goals related to the natural gas and oil industry, and how your degree, or certificate, will help you towards your goals. Describe personal or family influences that guided you into this career path, and how you would use your education to help the natural gas and oil industry. Please also include any financial needs or special considerations.
	Provide a resume that includes academic achievements, extracurricular activities, awards/recognitions, community service, and work history.
	Provide current transcript.
	Provide ACT and/or SAT test scores (if required by your educational institution).

STEM & Geology Workshops

For: Elementary, middle and high school science teachers

Annual STEM & geology teacher workshops provide our educators with factual knowledge about the natural gas and oil industry, along with the history, science, and geology behind it, to take back to their classrooms. Career connections are incorporated into the curriculums and lessons in order to help educate students about all of the opportunities that are available within the natural gas and oil industry. Participants receive curriculum books that meet state and national standards, and include background information and multiple hands-on activities for each unit. Teachers are also equipped with supplies for many of the curriculum activities, and numerous other educational and resourceful materials. Each workshop is worth CEU credits and when applicable, teachers are taken on field trips and optional Ashland graduate credits are available.



For: 5th - 12th grade classrooms & university level course classes

Petroleum Professionals, or "Petro Pros", is a FREE educational guest speaker program. Each presentation is uniquely designed for the needs of the classroom, the student's education level and current topic(s) being taught. Presentations can be done in-person or through video conferencing, and can include the basics of fossil fuels, the exploration and production of natural gas and oil in Ohio, the careers related to the industry, and more.

Career Fairs

For: Your school/district/regional career fair

Scholarships

Students can apply for a scholarship from January 1 through March 1, and the recipients are announced in May of each year. Scholarships are eligible for renewal for up to 4 years for qualifying students.

The Institute supports school science fair programs by offering students information on ideas and resources for natural gas and oil related projects, sponsoring Ohio Academy of Science's STEM State Science Fair Award #139, and judging at the state science fair.
