Course description: Spanish I is an introductory course that allows the student to explore the language in all four modes of communication, including reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Cultural topics will be introduced as well. The student will learn to discuss everyday items in their homes and in the classroom while communicating in Spanish. During this class, we will focus on developing the students' ability to read, write, speak, and listen in Spanish.

Classroom rules:

- 1. Be respectful of the teacher and of other students
- 2. Be prepared to learn everyday
- 3. Ask for help when you need it

Classroom Policies

Absent Policy: If a student has an excused absence from school, they will have as many days to make up the work as days they were absent. It is the student's responsibility to ask the teacher for the work they missed while they were absent. Any papers that were passed out during class will be in the absent work organizer under the column "Spanish I".

Late Work Policy: Classwork will only be accepted up to one day after it is due. If an assignment is submitted within one day after the due date, the student will lose 50% off of their grade. After one day, the assignment cannot be submitted for credit.

We will be using the textbook "Ven Conmigo" during Spanish I.

We will follow this rough overview during the year. During the year, we will be covering several units. During each unit, the students will be provided with a vocabulary list. The students will be responsible for studying the vocabulary list outside of class. The students will take a vocabulary quiz during each unit. Some units may include other assessments such as speaking tests, listening tests, reading tests, and writing

tests. The students will need to know the vocabulary words in order to perform well on quizzes and tests. The dates of tests and quizzes will be announced in advance. Students should use Quizlet to study.

We will use class time to study the words on the vocabulary lists through a variety of different activities such as worksheets, games, skits, videos, and songs. Students will also need to spend time outside of class studying vocabulary words, so that they can be prepared for the quizzes and tests in this class. Some units will be longer than others, so some vocabulary lists will be longer than others. I will use Progress Book to enter your student's grades, so I encourage you to check Progress Book regularly to monitor your student's progress in Spanish this quarter.
