





 GPA/Test scores are close to Ttheir average, admissions less than 35%


COMPETITIVE



Your Responsibilities

Request that your transcript be sent	College Visits-2 excused
Send standardized test scores (if needed separately from transcript)	Apply to take the ACT/SAT (If needed)
Ask for recommendation letters in advance (Don't wait until the last minute)	Find if your school is test optional
Send off college applications by the deadline	Read emails regularly
Know college deadlines especially if you are Early Decision/Early Admissions.	Apply for FAFSA pin starting Oct. 1st

My role in your Senior Planning

Discuss and plan coursework & grad requirements

Help students create a plan (Employment, Enrollment, Enlistment)
