

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Grade 2

English Language Arts - Grade 2 (36 Lessons)

The student will engage in a series of instructional assessment activities that enhance reading, writing, and comprehension. The student will expand and apply knowledge of grade-level appropriate vocabulary.

Math - Grade 2 (36 Lessons)

Math Grade 2 presents the following topics: number sense, fractions, operations, money, patterns, algebra, geometry, positions, using shapes, spatial sense, time, length, weight, capacity, temperature, graphing, using data, probability.

Social Studies - Grade 2 (36 Lessons)

Social Studies brings topics to life illustrating their relevance to today's students in a way that is engaging and interactive. This course utilizes the following: interactive maps, charts, graphs, topics in art, literature, science, math and ties into thematic research projects that enable cross-curricular exploration.

Science - Grade 2 (36 Lessons)

Science for primary grades gives students an interactive and engaging way to build scientific core knowledge and tie academic content to real-world exploration and application. This course utilizes: engaging activities in physics, chemistry, biology, and earth science; addresses science theory, principles, concepts, and real-world applications; and teaches students how to gather, organize, and interpret data.
