

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Grade 2

English Language Arts - Grade 3 (36 Lessons)

The student will apply comprehension strategies to literary and expository texts using think aloud prompts and scaffold support. The student will expand and apply knowledge of grade-level appropriate vocabulary. ELEMENTARY 6

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Math - Grade 3 (36 Lessons)

Math Grade 3 presents the following topics: number theory and systems, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals, money, patterns, algebra, properties of shapes, coordinate geometry, transformations and symmetry, time, customary system, metric system, perimeter and area, display and interpret data, probability, problem-solving.

Social Studies - Grade 3 (36 Lessons)

Social Studies brings topics to life illustrating their relevance to today's students in a way that is engaging and interactive. This course utilizes the following: interactive maps, charts, graphs, topics in art, literature, science, math and ties into thematic research projects that enable cross-curricular exploration.

Science - Grade 3 (36 Lessons)

Science for primary grades gives students an interactive and engaging way to build scientific core knowledge and tie academic content to real-world exploration and application. This course utilizes: engaging activities in physics, chemistry, biology, and earth science; addresses science theory, principles, concepts, and real-world applications; and teaches students how to gather, organize, and interpret data.
